

The Marion Fire/EMS Department (MFED) is seeking qualified EMT/Paramedics for immediate part-time employment. MFED is a municipal fire department operating two ALS ambulances in a small residential community. MFED is seeking to hire additional part-time staff in order to maintain 24/7/365 coverage. The staffing shall be a P/B configuration. Candidates should be at least 21 years of age, possess current Massachusetts Paramedic/EMT credentials, possess a current MA driver's license and pass a CORI check Paramedic candidates must possess or obtain Cape & Islands EMS authorization to practice. Paramedic candidates should have a minimum of two years 9-1-1 experience in their respective role, unless otherwise modified by the Chief. The work schedule consists of 12 hour shifts, 0600-1800 and 1800-0600 daily. Shift work is dependent on the individual's availability. Salaries range from 17.87-24.25 per hour based on experience as may be determined by the Chief.
