

SECTION 17: ENFORCEMENT.

17.10: The Board of Health or its duly appointed Health Agent are authorized to issue Notices of Violations, Cease and Desist Orders, and other enforcement orders to compel compliance with the terms of this Sanitary Code, as they deem necessary and appropriate. [December 6, 1988]

17.20: In addition to any other remedy, the Board of Health and/or its Agents may take any enforcement action deemed appropriate including but not limited to criminal prosecution, including fines as set forth in MGL Chapter 111, Section 31 or Civil Action in the Courts of the Commonwealth for injunctive relief and/or money damages, or both criminal and civil enforcement.
