

1.	John & Craig Lawrence	5 Pawkechatt Way	(SE41-1046)	Possible bordering vegetated wetlands violations taking place in the rear of the property.
2.	Bayberry Lane Association	Bayberry Lane (at the bottom)	(none)	Harbormaster reported wetlands violations near the shore.
3.	Nathan & Aida Elder	148 Spring Street	(41D-1200)	Repeat inspection regarding possible wetlands violations in the rear of the lot. The property lines were to have been staked.
4.	Sardinha Family Trust	454 Wareham Street	SE41-1140	Repeat inspection to expand the rear parking lot, install a landscape berm and a stormwater management system. The property lines were to have been staked.
5.	Marion Lands Trust LLC c/o David Croll	Holly Knoll, off Wareham Street	SE41-1137	Amendment to an order of conditions for landscaping activities. The amendment is to plant rhododendrons within 15' of wetlands in portion of the site in order to provide a vegetative buffer to the wetlands and mandatory boulder line.
6.	Alan L. Minard & Nancy S. Johnson	Lot 30 Allens Point Road	SE41-1110	Amendment to an order of conditions to construct a dwelling, driveway and septic system, fill/grade and replicate wetlands. The amendment is for changes to the dwelling and driveway footprints and locations, grading schematic and utility layouts.
7.	Massachusetts Dept. of Transportation (optional?)	Along Routes 6, 105 and I-195	41D-1426	Trim/remove all dead/dying/unsafe trees within the road layouts.
