7:01 PM **TABOR ACADEMY**, Ryder Lane, Request for Determination Applicability (File No. 41D-1531) to raze a 12' x 16' stone building, loam and seed the area and eventually plant a low-grade hedge in its place. M. Vander Pol said the roof will be saved for a future project (possibly in Wareham) and the stones may be saved. He said he believes the manhole beside the building was an old cesspool that was filled with sand during the turf project. J. Doubrava moved to close the hearing; C. Trinidad seconded; voted unanimously.

40 (File No. 41D-1532) to upgrade a sewage disposal system. Susan Nilson of CLE Engineering

54 existing stone licensed pier in order to create a 6' wide by 30' long walkway. Mr. Hirshmann's
55 caretaker, was present and described the work. There will be no change in the footprint. The slab
56 will be approximately 4" thick fastened to the rocks. J. Doubrava moved to close; C. Trinidad
57 seconded; voted unanimously.

60 Determination of Applicability (File No. 41D-1534) to cut a footpath 3-4' wide in the southwest part

62 edge of the water. Yelana Sheynin, the Lands Trust Head Steward described the project. N. Hills
63 said work will take place in wetlands and will need a Notice of Intent filing. She has promised the
64 donor of the land that work will start in July. N. Hills said the minimal amount of work should be
65 done until the NOI is filed in 6 months and an order issued. J. Doubrava moved to close; C. Trinidad
