

1.	Peter and Asha Wallace	167 Converse Road	SE41-1180	Maintain two grass paths and two view corridors. Work includes selective tree cutting, underbrush trimming, removal of invasive species, and planting of wetland trees and shrubs as mitigation.
2.	Gale P. Runnells	17 Reservation Way	SE41-1165	Certificate of Compliance for constructing additions to the dwelling. The phragmites eradication portion of the Order will remain in effect.
3.	Steven Hurley	21 Bayview Road	41D-1485	Landscape the yard with gardens and granite stepping stone pathways.
4.	Town of Marion	Giffords Corner Road (at the end)	SE41-1123	Certificate of Compliance (full) for installing a 12" drainage pipe with culverts, replicating wetlands, and associated grading.
5A.	Tabor Academy	Lillard Hall, 215 Front Street	(none)	Is a filing necessary to place a temporary 8' x 10' storage shed north of the building?
5B.	Marion Lands Trust, LLC	369 Wareham Street	SE41-1115	Three-year Extension Permit to replace 1,900 sq. ft. of pavement with lawn and plantings, and pave 860 sq. ft.
6.	Solo Realty LLC	102 Quails Crossing Road	SE41-1168	Certificate of Compliance for upgrading the septic system.
7.	George and Lois Graboys	95 Holly Road	SE41-1178	Construct a 4'-wide by 258'-long elevated boardwalk/walkway with a 4' x 12' platform to store kayaks and canoes. The boardwalk will begin at an existing deck and end with stairs landward of mean high water. It will be supported using a metal helical support system. THE END OF THE WALKWAY HAS BEEN STAKED.
