  - MHC has approved Tremont Camp Meeting National Register eligibility. Eric will proceed with nomination. Owners were notified.
6. CPC 26 planning: Proceed with consideration of National Register nomination for Marion Village to recognize and honor its historic importance with no limitations on owners. Publicity/information on National Register to be reviewed. Timing important to make it part of the 175<sup>th</sup> Town Anniversary in 2027.
