

**TOWN OF MARION**  
**Water & Sewer Rate Schedule**

The consumption periods are March 1<sup>st</sup> – May 31<sup>st</sup> (bills will be sent in June) June 1<sup>st</sup> – August 31<sup>st</sup> (bills will be sent in Sept) Sept 1<sup>st</sup> – Nov 30<sup>th</sup> (bills will be sent in Dec) Dec 1<sup>st</sup> – Feb 28<sup>th</sup> (bills will be sent in March).

All charges are due and payable 30 days from the original billing date. Delinquent accounts will be charged a \$10.00 demand fee and interest of 14% per annum will be calculated daily until full payment is received.

\$41.94 per 1,000 cu. ft. (1 to 1,000 cu. ft.)	
\$101.15 per 1,000 cu. ft. (1,001 to 2,000 cu. ft.)	
\$166.09 per 1,000 cu. ft. (2,001 cu. ft. to 3,000 cu. ft.)	
\$185.43 per 1,000 cu. ft. (3,001 cu. ft. and over)	
<b><u>Metered Sewer Rates</u></b>	
Sewer usage is based on 100% of the water used.	
\$77.49 per 1,000 cu. ft. (1 to 1,000 cu. ft.)	
\$221.21 per 1,000 cu. ft. (1,001 to 2,000 cu. ft.)	
\$357.17 per 1,000 cu. ft. (2,001 cu. ft. to 3,000 cu. ft.)	
\$388.78 per 1,000 cu. ft. (3,001 cu. ft. and over)	

**Basic Charges**  
Basic charges for water & sewer are based on the meter size.

1. All meters used by water & sewer customers shall be furnished and owned by the Town of Marion. Any meter injured by frost, or through negligence of a water customer shall be repaired or replaced at the owner's expense.
2. All water that passes through a meter will be charged to the customer; regardless of leaks, burst pipes, or irrigation use.
3. Failure of owner or customer to receive a bill does not relieve him/her from obligation of its payment or consequences of nonpayment.
4. No person except the authorized employee of the Water Division will be allowed to install, remove, or repair any meter.
5. The property owner or customer must keep such meter accessible for reading and inspection at all times.
6. When a meter fails to register the consumption, the quantity shall be estimated either by the previous readings or by the number of people living in the house during that time.
