Collection Schedule

All solid waste and recyclables should be placed in carts and placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your current collection day. Recycling will be collected every other week on Wednesday. A Collection Calendar and Service Day schedule is included in this guide for your convenience.

- Monday trash collection/Wednesday Recycling Green week
- Tuesday trash collection/Wednesday Recycling Gold week
- Friday trash collection/Wednesday Recycling Gold week

Collection Guidelines

- All carts are property of the Town and must remain at the property where they are delivered.
- All regular household refuse must be bagged and placed in the GREEN cart for collection.
- All recycling must be placed loose in the BLUE cart for collection, do not place plastic bags in the recycling cart, they are unacceptable.
- The lids on the cart must be firmly closed and no materials may be left outside the cart. Any items left outside the cart will not be collected.
- A list of acceptable recycling material is provided on the adjacent page.

Cart Care & Placement

- Always keep the lid closed to keep rain, snow and animals out.
- Clean the cart periodically.
- Since automated waste collection requires clearance for the vehicle's lifting mechanism, any cars parked at the curb should be at least 5 feet from the trash cart.
- Place your cart at least 3 feet away from any obstacles to allow the automatic arm to lift and empty the cart. Place the wheels of the cart toward your house.
